<u>Prior Learning</u>: online and offline, SMART rules, what a web browser is, email is a good form of communication, how to use a search engine to find a picture, personal information should be kept private from strangers online

Core Knowledge- non-negotiable- specific knowledge must be identified here

- Give examples of how technology is used to communicate beyond school (i.e. email, Skype or FaceTime).
- Know the tules of using technology at home or in school.
- Understand that once something is posted, control of it is lost.
- Understand that everyone leaves a digital footprint.
- Understand that some things may upset them online.
- Understand that not everyone online can be trusted (not everyone is who they say they are).
- Use online services to communicate safely (relationships online).
- Understand what to do to get help online if needed.
- Give examples of online bullying behaviour.
- Understand the impact online bullying may have and know where to go for support.
- Explain what personal information is and understand the need for passwords to protect it.
- Understand that content online is owned by the person who created it.
- Use a search engine and be aware that not everything you read online is true.
