Core knowledge:

- the United Kingdom is made up of 4 countries – England, Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland
- each country has a capital city – London, Edinburgh, Cardiff, Belfast
- capital city is a city that is the centre of government of a country or smaller political area
- identify the characteristics of each country – eg weather, physical & human features #
- name and locate the surrounding seas of the UK
