Name and locate geographical regions and their identifying human and physical characteristics within the United Kingdom and understand how land use has changed over time

**Core knowledge:**

- understand what a region is
- identify the regions of the UK
- name all 12 regions of the UK
- identify human and physical characteristics of each region
- understand how land use has changed over time
- identify key topographical features on a map (including hills, mountains, coasts and rivers)

**Wider influences**

- comparing and contrasting areas
- looking at regions over time
- accents
- food

**Enduring understanding:**

- name different regions of the UK
- locate regions of the UK on a map
- understand changes that have happened in different regions

**Working geographically:**

- identify and describe human and physical characteristics (key topographical features and land-use) of the geographical regions of the UK
- observe how key physical and human characteristics of the regions of the UK have changed over time
- use maps to identify the regions (including topographical and relief map)
- interpret a range of sources of geographical information regarding the UK (eg maps, diagrams, globes, aerial photographs)
- use eight points on a compass to describe the location of the geographical regions of the UK
- use four figure grid references and OS map symbols to locate specific places within the UK
